## PAMP Science Air Day

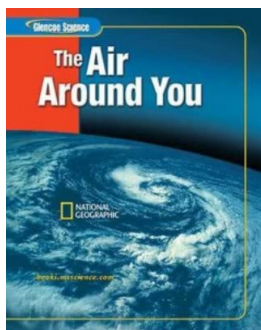
When: Saturday, 9/12

## Club Day

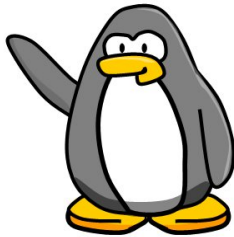

## Step Out

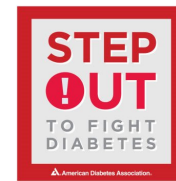
When: Sunday, 9/27
